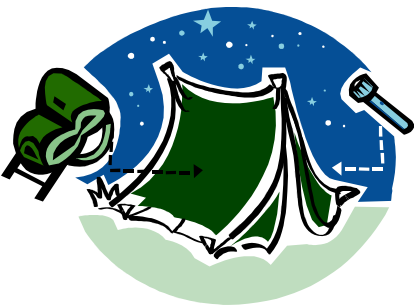
## PreSchool Explorers and After School Adventurers

- March 15/16:** First Wildflowers - Come hike the Honey Hollow trails with us and discover the wonders of the first of the season wildflower: The SKUNK CABBAGE!
- March 29/30:** Rotten Log - Join our search for the FBI (Fungus, Bugs, Insects) as the days grow warmer and longer and they emerge from their winter sleep.
- April 12/13:** FROGS!! We'll hike to the marsh and check out our frog population as they begin the spring singing season
